FROM THE OFFICE OF FAITH DEVELOPMENT: Spirit of Vatican II: Exploring the Documents that Shaped an Age will take place over 6 evenings beginning Tuesday, September 21st at St. Bernard's church basement. Join Dr. Andrew Wilson as he examines the documents of Vatican II and the culture that led to Pope John XXIII's decision to "throw open the window and let fresh air into the church". Dr. Wilson asks that participants purchase A Concise Guide to the Documents of Vatican II by Edward P. Hahnenberg for use during the sessions, which is available at the Vision Book Store at a cost of \$20. They will also need to access the documents discussed themselves, which can be downloaded from the Vatican website (www.vatican.va) or are all contained in Vatican Council II: Constitutions, Decrees, Declarations by Austin Flannery, also available for purchase from the Book Store. Both books will be available the first evening should folks not be able to get to the Book Store beforehand. Dr. Wilson is a professor with the Department of Religious Studies at Mount Allison University. He is a popular presenter in the archdiocese and has facilitated discussions on various topics.
