

## Living in the Light of the Gospels

"Christians believe in the God of Jesus Christ;" so stated Fr. Luc Tardif, as he began the first session of *Living in the Light of the Gospels*, this year's English Deanery Mission. And to find out who Jesus Christ is, we must look to



the Gospels. Within the message of the Gospels, Fr. Tardif suggests we pay particular attention to the beginning and ending verses of each Gospel. The Gospel of Mark starts with "The beginning of the good news of Jesus Christ, the Son of God." For Fr. Tardif, this means, that the good news is always beginning for us – we need to forget the past and not be stuck in what was ... we are beginning anew, over and over again. Mark's is a Gospel of conversion, and that conversion is one of mind, heart and will.
